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Mission and Purpose

Mayee Futterman Art enriches, inspires, and transforms people's lives through Chinese Brush Painting art, collections, education, events, social media, and cultural connections.

Artistic Focus

Mayee Futterman Art is a globally renowned Chinese Brush Painting talent. She is featured in private and corporate collections worldwide. She is a leading authority in transformative Chinese Brush Painting education, fostering community engagement through paint party events for corporations and nonprofits, and connecting with audiences worldwide through social media.

Origins and Evolution

Rooted in three decades of mastery, Futterman's art is shaped by the traditions of Xiěyì ("writing the idea"), Shān-shuǐ ("mountain and water"), and Pò-mò ("splash ink") painting. Trained under a leading Chinese Brush Painting master, she has developed a contemporary approach that honors lineage while extending its reach to new audiences through education, digital platforms, and large-scale commissions.

Artistic Language

Her work embodies the harmony of opposites—control and spontaneity, strength and grace, emptiness and fullness. Using traditional ink and mineral pigments on rice paper, she captures the living energy of nature across a diverse range of subjects including flora, land creatures, sea creatures, birds and insects, and landscapes, among others.

Notable Work

Futterman's major commissions include a mural and over 30 paintings at the Los Angeles Center for Women's Health, four large works in the Caesars New Orleans Asian Gaming Room, and "Fluid Power," a winning entry for BMW's international design competition for the limited edition M4 GT4. Exhibitions include Descanso Gardens Sturt-Haaga Gallery, the historic Altadena Country Club, APIA Scholars, and Creative World Arts, Arcadia, CA. She currently has two artist residencies for the Segerstrom Center for the Arts, Arts Teach, and The Brush Warrior Project at the California Veterans Home, West Los Angeles.

 - **The Brush Warrior Project:** teaching Chinese Brush Painting to senior citizen veteran residents at the Veterans Home of California, West Los Angeles serving the disabled and those in memory care.
 - **Segerstrom Center for the Arts, Arts Teach:** teaching K-12 students including special needs and alternative education throughout Orange County, CA.

Artist Statement: Mayee Futterman Artist



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Through simple, dynamic, and sensuous ink-wash brush strokes, my art integrates gesture, allegory, and emotion to interpret the vitality of life. Driven by innate resonance and 3 decades of Chinese Brush Painting mastery, my multicultural experience inspires new approaches to classical themes. Specializing in spontaneous Xiěyì 寫意 style, I express spirit and substance through harmony in duality.

Mayee is an award-winning exhibiting, teaching, and published visual artist. Her works are collected and commissioned internationally including Caesars New Orleans and the Los Angeles Center for Women's Health at California Hospital Medical Center. Mayee

won BMW's international design competition for the limited edition M4 GT4 and artist grants with the Picerne Family Foundation and Segerstrom Center for the Arts. Mayee co-authored six instructional art books, was showcased in several solo and group exhibitions, and featured on CNN and NTD TV.

Mayee teaches a diverse student population of all ages, skill levels, educational and cultural backgrounds, and life stages including those with minor to advanced physical disabilities and mental health challenges. She's an instructor at UCLA Extension, Huntington Beach Art Center, the Segerstrom Center for the Arts Arts-Teach program, Creative Arts Group in Sierra Madre, Veterans Home of California, the Institute of Chinese Language and Culture, and Mayee Futterman Live-On-Line.

Mayee's curriculum and instructional system are adaptable to any setting including preschool to high school, community education centers, corporate locations, art and cultural centers, and higher education. Her classes enjoy a worldwide following. During the pandemic alone, Mayee's classes reached approximately 25 countries in 6 continents and 38 U.S. states. Her student retention is over 5,000 new and recurring sign-ups totaling over 25,000 person-hours taught.

Mayee's home, family, and art studio are in Long Beach. She teaches throughout Southern California and worldwide.

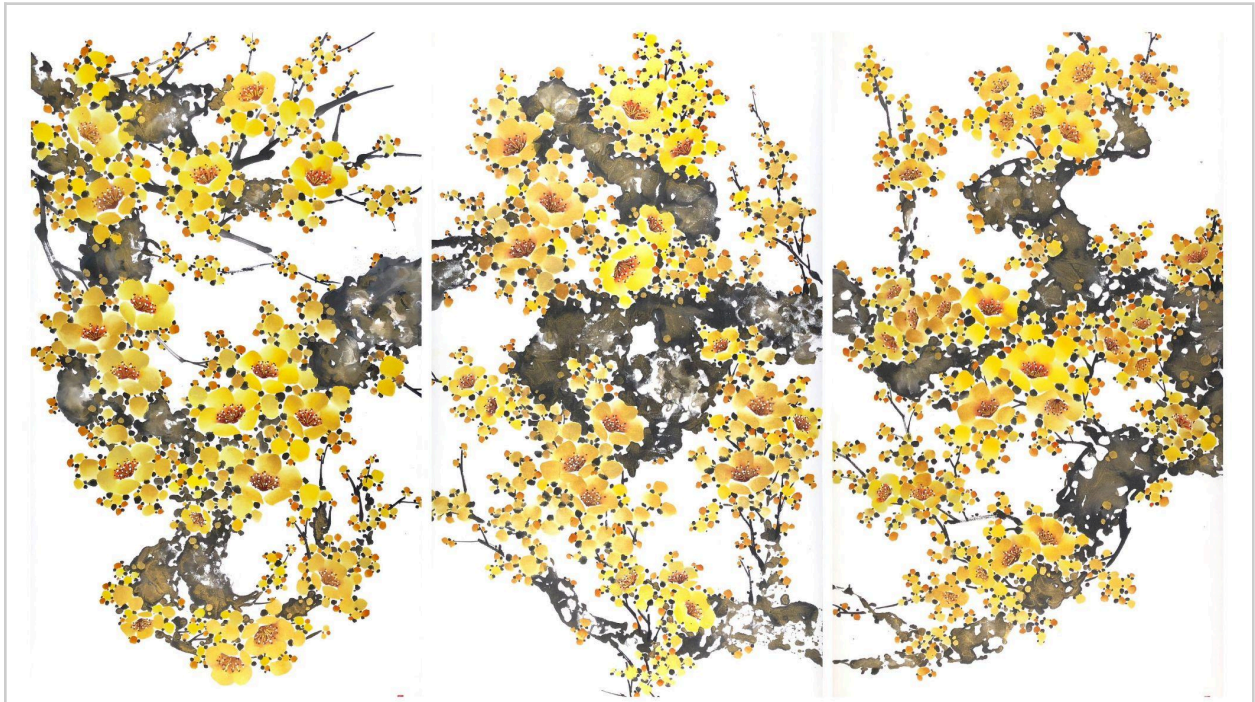

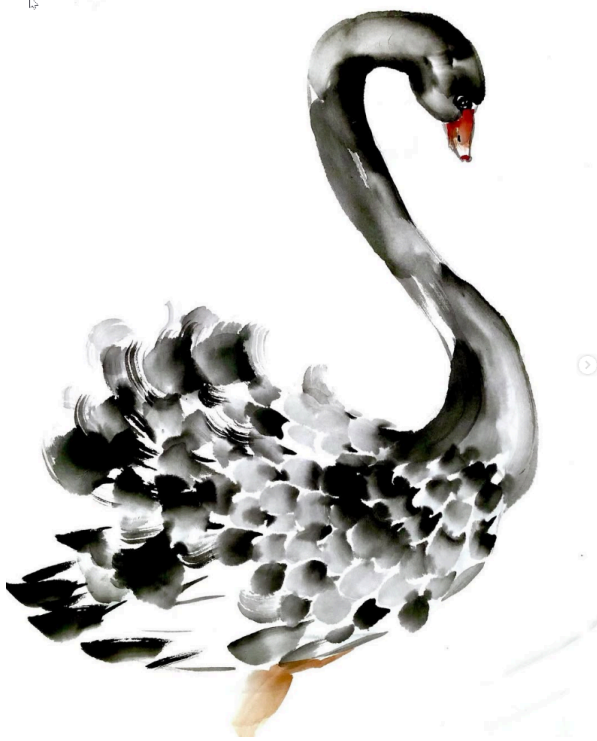
